SAN ANTONIO AND WASHINGTON, DC – Jane H. Macon and Danielle M. Varnell have been named South Trailblazers by *The American Lawyer* for 2022. They are among the 54 lawyers in the southern region of the United States recognized for their significant mark on the practice, policy and technological advancements in their practice areas.

Macon, a partner in the firm's San Antonio office, focuses her practice on public finance and administrative law, public and private partnerships, real estate, civil litigation, zoning, platting, condemnation and municipal bonds. She made San Antonio history when she became the first woman to serve as city attorney from 1977 to 1983.
