

Bracewell Advises Matrix Renewables on 1GW/2GWh Battery Storage Projects

LONDON – Bracewell (UK) LLP represented Matrix Renewables, the TPG-rise backed renewable energy platform, on its agreement with Green BESS Developments (UK) Limited to acquire two standalone battery energy system (BESS) projects in Scotland. The transaction marks Matrix's entry into the UK market.
