

# Donald Trump's Call for 'Energy Dominance' is Likely to Run into Real-World Limits

President-elect Donald Trump is set to create a National Energy Council that he says will establish American “energy dominance” around the world. The energy council is to be led by Trump’s choice to head the Interior Department – North Dakota Governor Doug Burgum.

Bracewell’s **Scott Segal** told the *Associated Press* that the idea of centering energy decisions at the White House follows an example set by President Joe Biden, who named a trio of White House advisers to lead on climate policy. Segal also called Burgum “a steady hand on the tiller” with experience in fossil fuels and renewables.
